


In Scripture

IN SCRIPTURE is a seven-episode anthology exploring the Bible's most mysterious and fragmented moments—those passages where Scripture gives only a glimpse, yet leaves questions unanswered.

Through reverent imagination, cinematic realism, and spiritual depth, each episode reveals the humanity and divine tension hidden between the lines of the biblical narrative.

SERIES FORMAT

- Format: 7-episode anthology
- Length: ~30 minutes per episode
- Genre: Faith-driven mystery / biblical thriller
- Tone: Cinematic, meditative, spiritually resonant
- Style: Each episode stands alone, unified through theme and world building

EPISODE GUIDE

1. *Myster Disciple* — A stranger casts out demons in Jesus' name.
2. *A Certain Young Man* — A boy flees Gethsemane in terror and shame.
3. *His Father's Nakedness* — A moment of dishonor becomes a generational curse.
4. *Beseech Thy Glory* — Moses returns changed after seeing God's glory.
5. *Woe Unto That Man* — Two conflicting accounts reveal Judas' tragic fate.
6. *Bewail The Vow* — A warrior's promise brings devastating consequences.
7. *The Lord's Brethren* — Jesus' siblings confront faith, family, and legacy.

Episode 1 - Myster Disciple

A mysterious man casts out demons in Jesus' name — yet he is not one of the Twelve.

Mark 9:38

This episode explores the identity, power, and spiritual tension behind this unnamed disciple whom Scripture acknowledges only briefly.

Episode 2 - A Certain Young Man

Mark 14:51,52

Scripture tells us what happened, but not how it felt.

This episode explores the internal dynamics of a divine encounter.




Episode 5 - Woe Unto That Man

Scripture gives two conflicting accounts of Judas' death.

Matthew 27:5 & Acts 1:18

This episode confronts betrayal, guilt, and the terrifying judgment that follows sin — revealing the human story behind the man history condemned.



Episode 6 - Bewail The Vow

Before going to war, Jephthah vows to sacrifice “the first thing that comes out of his house” if God grants him victory.

He wins.

And the first to greet him... is his daughter.

Judges 11:30,31

A tragic meditation on devotion, consequence, and the silence where Scripture leaves us to imagine the rest.

Episode 7 - The Lord's Brethren

The true story of Jesus' own siblings who did not believe who He was.

Matthew 13:55-58

Told from the perspective of his half-brother, James.

From an unbeliever to the redeemed.

A second chance farewell before The Ascension.
